This Memorandum of Understanding ("MoU") is made and entered into as of 27 May, 2025 by and between Impact Hub Hyderabad (Hyderabad Impact Hub Private Limited), and Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam (SPMVV), aimed at collaboration between the organizations to collaborate on multiple areas of entrepreneurship and Social Innovation.

The Impact Hub Hyderabad (Hyderabad Impact Hub Private Limited) is part of a global network of collaborative spaces designed to support social entrepreneurs and innovators who are working to address pressing social and environmental challenges. Located in the heart of the city (Kondapur, Hyderabad), it provides a dynamic environment for individuals and organizations to connect, collaborate, and grow their ideas. With a focus on fostering creativity, innovation, and sustainable change, Impact Hub Hyderabad offers co-working spaces, events, and resources that empower local impact makers to drive positive change in their communities and beyond. Sri Padmavati Mahila Visvavidyalayam (SPMVV), Tirupati represented by its Vice-Chancellor, Prof.V.Uma, is a government state-level University recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC) under the UGC Act of 1956 and accredited by NAAC with 'A+' Grade, located in the city of Tirupati in Tirupati district of Andhra Pradesh. The university was founded in the year 1983 by Sri N.T.Rama Rao, the then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh, with the fervent desire to train women students as better builders of the nation and to inculcate skills of leadership in all aspects of life. Currently, the University offers a comprehensive range of 50 courses at both the undergraduate and postgraduate levels, with a strong focus on research.

The University has a vibrant research, innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem facilitated by the Central Govt funded centers across the campus namely Technology Business Incubator (TBI), Women Biotech Incubation Facility (WBIF), Tepp Outreach cum Cluster Innovation Centre (TOCIC), Rural Women Technology Park (RWTP), Institution Innovation Council (IIC) and Livelihood Business Incubator (LBI). Purpose

This MoU sets forth the intentions of Impact Hub Hyderabad and SPMVV to collaborate on supporting startups within the SPMVV network, with a primary focus on collaborating to facilitate international market entry and explore joint global opportunities in international projects.

Scope of Collaboration

The Parties agree to explore opportunities for collaboration and cooperation, leveraging each other's expertise and resources to achieve common goals. This MoU provides a framework for future discussions and the development of initiatives that support the objectives of both Parties.

Social Innovation: Leveraging Impact Hub Hyderabad's expertise in supporting social enterprises, this collaboration will nurture student-led and faculty-led social innovation projects at SPMVV, providing mentorship, incubation, and access to a broader innovation ecosystem. Possible collaboration for Impact Hub Hyderabad's flagship initiative on Social Entrepreneurship - Social Impact Award (SIA) program.

Female Founders Initiative: Recognizing the need to empower women entrepreneurs, this initiative will focus on capacity building, leadership training, and startup support tailored for female founders, ensuring they have the resources and network to scale their ventures with the support of Impact Hub's Global Network and especially with the German, Austrian and Swiss Ecosystem of Women Entrepreneurs.

International Commercialization of Startups: With Impact Hub's global reach in 70+ countries, startups emerging from SPMVV will be guided on market entry strategies, global partnerships, and investment opportunities, enabling them to scale beyond regional and national boundaries.

Terms of Understanding

- This MoU is non-binding and does not constitute any legal agreement. It outlines the intentions of both parties to collaborate and does not create any enforceable rights or obligations to either party to this agreement.

Duration and Termination

- This MoU shall come into effect on the date of signing and remain in effect for [01 Year], unless terminated earlier by either party upon [30 days] written notice.

Confidentiality

- Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality of any proprietary or sensitive information shared during the course of the collaboration, unless required by law to disclose.



Amendments

- Any amendments to this MoU must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
