
1. The Advisory members of IQAC are informed that the latest NAAC Grade A+ obtained is valid for 5 years from **3 January, 2023** and are shown the certifications received from NAAC Office. As per the information received from Dr. Prashant Prahad, Deputy Adviser, NAAC, the university is to give AQAR for the year 2022-23 from 1 June, 2022 to 31 May 2023. In this regard the IQAC Director is advised to further make a request to NAAC to change the period of AQAR from 1 July, 2022 to 30 June 2023.
2. It is resolved by the members to renew the Green, Environment and Energy audits as per the new directions of NAAC which is mandatory for all institutions. The Director and the Deputy Director Prof. T. Sita Kumari will take up the responsibility.
3. The recommendations of the recent NAAC Peer Team have been reviewed.
4. It is proposed that a letter of request may be sent through proper channel to the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh and APSCHE for the exemption of SPMVV from the AP Post Graduate Common Entrance Test and APRCET as the enrollment losses are rampant in PG admissions and the rate of admission into PhD is proportionately dropping (109 PhD seats are vacant till 2nd counselling in the APRCET 2022) for the last consecutive 4 years which sets out to be a valid ground contributive to the gender parity in the State of Andhra Pradesh in Higher education. Further since SPMVV is in X schedule, the institution has to be given free hand in conducting its PG CET and RCET to cater to the women students of both the Telugu speaking states.
5. It is advised to continue the practice of identifying a Faculty Coordinator in each Department/Centre to be responsible in sending the data to IQAC as and when required.
6. It is resolved to conduct a Faculty Training Workshop on Process involved in writing Program outcomes, Course Outcomes and mapping of Course curriculum. Prof. Amuthavalli will help in arranging resource persons.
7. It is suggested to write to the departments to develop e-content for electives to begin with, to ensure hybrid mode of learning process.
