
QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE ASSISTANT PROFESSORS

- i. Good academic record as defined by the concerned university with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in a relevant subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.
- iii. Candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions.

“Provided further, the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bylaws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges /Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- a. Ph.D. degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only;
- b. Evaluation of the Ph.D. thesis by at least two external examiners;
- c. Open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate had been conducted;
- d. Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work out of which at least one must be in a refereed journal;
- e. Candidate has made at least two presentations in conferences/seminars, based on his/her Ph.D work.
- f. (a) to (e) as above are to be certified by the Vice-Chancellor/Pro-Vice-Chancellor/Dean (Academic Affairs)/Dean (University instructions).”

"Ph.D. degrees which are pursued either full time or part time will be treated as degrees awarded through Regular Mode provided these are in conformity with the existing Statutes/Bye laws/Ordinances etc. of the degree awarding University. However, the Ph.D. acquired under distance mode is not permitted”.

- iv. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted.
- v. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and Masters level for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Differently-abled (physically and visually differently-abled) /Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non-creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- vi. A relaxation of 5% may be provided, from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders, who have obtained their Master's Degree prior to 19 September, 1991. Relevant grade which is regarded as equivalent of 55% wherever the grading system is followed by a recognized university shall also be considered eligible.

In addition to the above Qualifications for the post of **Assistant Professor**, the candidates shall satisfy the following requirements, for consideration of their applications:

Education (General)

A Master's Degree in Arts/Humanities/Sciences and M.Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed);

OR

M.A. (Education) and B.Ed. each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed); and

Any other stipulation prescribed by the UGC/such other affiliating body/State Government, from time to time for the positions of Assistant Professors (Lecturers), shall be mandatory.

Special Education

A Master's Degree in Arts/Humanities/Sciences and M.Sc in Speech and Hearing/M.A.S.L.P. and M.Ed. Special (H.I) each with a minimum of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).

Music & Fine Arts

Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) at the Master's Degree level in Music or an equivalent degree from an Indian/Foreign University.

Social Work

First/Second Class (not less than 55%) Master Degree in Social Work and Ph.D. in Social Work or NET/SLET/SET in the concerned subject.

Dept. of Women's Studies-Subject:Economics

First/Second Class (not less than 55%) Master Degree in Economics/Econometrics/Applied Economics and Ph.D. in the subject concerned or NET/SLET/SET in the concerned subject.

Applied Mathematics

First/Second Class (not less than 55%) Masters Degree in Mathematics/Applied Mathematics and Ph.D. in the concerned subject or NET/SLET/SET in the concerned subject.

Pharmacy

Essential

A basic degree in Pharmacy (B.Pharm)

Registration as a pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act, 1948, as amended from time to time, including any succeeding enactments.

First Class Master's Degree in appropriate branch of specialization in Pharmacy

Desirable

Teaching, research industrial and/or professional experience in a reputed organization; and papers presented at Conferences and/or in refereed journals.

Specializations:

Pharmaceutics/Pharmaceutical
Chemistry/Pharmacology/Pharmaceutical Analysis.

ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY

i. Essential

First class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) and Technology (Tech.)

Preference will be given to the candidates who possess First Class in the Bachelor's degree also in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) and Technology (Tech.)

ii. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered **desirable**:

1. Teaching, research industrial and / or professional experience in a reputed organization;

2. Papers presented at Conferences and / or in refereed journals.
